Right to Withdraw Consent: You may withdraw your consent provided to us for the processing of your PI by sending a mail to our Grievance Officer using the details mentioned below. Please note, however, that this may lead to a discontinuation in discharging the purposes for which such PI is collected.

Security and Confidentiality: We strive to ensure the security, integrity and privacy of your PI and to protect your information against unauthorized access or unauthorized alteration, disclosure or destruction. We adopt adequate measures to prevent unauthorized access to your information and have implemented the ISO/IEC 27001:2013 standards as prescribed under applicable law.

# 5. Disclosures and Transfer

All PI and SPI that we collect is disclosed or transferred only under the following circumstances and only to entities/individuals who adhere to similar levels of security standards as maintained by us to ensure security, integrity and privacy of your information. Disclosures to affiliates/group companies: We and our affiliates/group companies receive information from and share information with each other for the purposes of your employment or engagement with us.
